**AMENDED ORDER
DESIGNATING JUVENILE
PROCESSING OFFICES
As per §§ 52.025 Texas Family Code**

IT IS THE ORDER OF THE JUVENILE COURT, Hunt County, Texas, that the following places in Hunt County, Texas are designated as a Juvenile Processing Office(s) for the temporary detention of a child taken into custody under Section 52.025 et seq of the Juvenile Justice Code:

A: The Juvenile Processing Offices for the following entities in Hunt County are listed in the Order and specifically exclude any cell or holding facility.

Bland ISD Police Department	Police office located in Bland HS; Police office located in Bland Elementary
Boles ISD SRO	SRO Office – Boles Highschool
Caddo Mills Police Department	Interview Room 1
Caddo Mills ISD SRO	Griffis Elementary room A04 and A03; Lee Elementary will be conference room 1, 2 and principal’s office; Caddo Mills Middle School will be principal’s office and counselor’s office; Caddo Mills High School will be principal’s office, counselor’s office, assistant principal’s office and Chief’s PD office
Campbell ISD	Hunt County Sheriff’s Office designated rooms
Commerce Police Department	Room 143
Commerce ISD Police Department	Commerce Middle School central office; Commerce HS room B128
Greenville Police Department	Briefing /Squad room and Patrol Sergeant’s office
Greenville ISD Police Department	SRO office at Greenville HS 0-1; Greenville Middle School SRO office located in the central office

B. All Justices of the Peace Courts of Hunt County, Texas, including offices and hearing rooms, excluding any cell or holding facility.

A child may be detained in a juvenile processing office only for the following:

1. The return of the child to the custody of a person under Section 52.02(a)(1)
2. The completion of essential forms and records required by the juvenile court or this title.
3. The photographing and fingerprinting of the child if otherwise authorized at the time of temporary detention by this title.
4. The issuance of warnings to the child as required or permitted by this title; or
5. The receipt of a statement by the child under Section 51.095 (a)(1)(2)(3) or (5)


This office may not be a cell or holding facility used for detentions other than detention under this section.

C. A child may not be left unattended in a Juvenile Processing Office and is entitled to be accompanied by the child's parent, guardian, or other custodian or by the child's attorney.


D. A child may not be detained in a Juvenile Processing Office for longer than six hours.

If at any time the Juvenile Board of Hunt County learns of any agency violating any terms of this order, said agency may be removed from having a Juvenile Processing Office upon its premises.
