Residential contract(s) submitted for review were Pegasus Schools. Residential contracts between counties are not subject to this audit. Nonresidential contract(s) reviewed under the scope of this audit were Roberta Jacobs. Nonresidential contracts with less than \$5,000 in expenditures are not subject to this audit. All requested documentation was received in an organized and timely manner. Staff from TJJD recommends that the department continue to seek programs and services to serve juvenile offenders. Please note: There were no findings identified during this fiscal monitoring of FY2023 expenditures. The Hunt County Juvenile Probation Department should continue to evaluate its Residential and Nonresidential entities on an annual basis.
