2010 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This Agreement is made and entered into this 24th day of June, 2010, by and between The COUNTY of Hunt, acting by and through its governing body, the Commissioners Court, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the CITY of Greenville, acting by and through its governing body, the City Council, hereinafter referred to as CITY, both of Hunt County, State of Texas witnesseth:

**WHEREAS**, this Agreement is made under the authority of Sections 791.011, Government Code: and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party: and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement: and

**WHEREAS**, the CITY agrees to provide the COUNTY \$5,704.00 from the JAG award for the Vehicle Program: and

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and COUNTY believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds.

**NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:**

**Section 1.**

CITY agrees to pay COUNTY a total of \$5,704.00 of JAG funds.

**Section 2.**

COUNTY agrees to use \$5,704.00 for the Vehicle Program until September 30, 2013 (date).

**Section 3.**

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Texas Tort Claims Act.

**Section 4.**

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the Texas Tort Claims Act.

**Section 5.**

Each party to this agreement will be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

**Section 6.**

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.


**Section 7.**


