


Congratulations! We are pleased to announce that the Texas Historical Commission voted to award Texas Historic Courthouse Preservation Program (THCPP) funding for the development of **architectural plans and specifications** for the Hunt County Courthouse. We appreciate all the hard work that went into your application. The competition for grants in Round IX of the program was strong. Of the twenty-five applicants from across the state, the commissioners selected four major construction projects, three small emergency projects, and one planning project. The Round IX grants total \$20,162,369. Details are now posted on our website.

Due to the limited state funds available, none of the Round IX grant recipients selected for non-emergency funding were granted their full request. Your project has been selected to receive \$642,440 or 90% of your \$713,822 planning request. With these state funds, we hope to ensure that plans are prepared which fully anticipate the work necessary to fully restore the Hunt County Courthouse to its original appearance.

To take this project forward, a meeting will be necessary at the earliest opportunity to discuss the project scope, timeline, and grant requirements. The county representative(s) should attend along with your project architect. This will enable the THC and Hunt County to prepare a Funding Agreement for this project. James Malanaphy, your THCPP Project Reviewer, should be contacted to make the arrangements for this meeting at 512-475-3285.
