WHEREAS, the federal off-system bridge program is administered by the Texas Department of Transportation (the State) to replace or rehabilitate structurally deficient and functionally obsolete (collectively referred to as deficient) bridges located on public roads and streets off the designated state highway system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville, a Local Government whose jurisdiction is overlapping with Hunt County, owns a bridge located at Farber Creek Branch on Shelby Avenue, National Bridge Inventory (NBI) Structure Number 01-117-0-AA09-16-002; and

WHEREAS, a project to remedy the bridge is included in the currently approved program of projects as authorized by Texas Transportation Commission Minute Order Number 115814 dated August 27, 2020, Control-Section-Job (CSJ) Number 0901-22-122; and

WHEREAS, the usual fund participation ratio for projects on such program is 80 percent federal, 10 percent state and 10 percent Local Government; and

WHEREAS, Texas Administrative Code, Title 43, Section 15.55(d) (43 TAC Section 15.55(d)) provides that under specified conditions the Local Government fund participation requirement may be waived with agreement by the Local Government to perform, or cause to be performed, an equivalent dollar amount of structural improvement work on other deficient bridges or deficient mainlane cross-drainage structures within its jurisdiction or the jurisdiction of a geographically adjacent or geographically overlapping governmental unit, such a project of structural improvement work being referred to as an equivalent-match project (EMP); and

WHEREAS, the estimated local match fund participation requirements on the approved federal off-system bridge projects is \$28,548 (dollars), hereinafter referred to as the participation-waived project (PWP), such participation requirement the Local Government proposes be waived; and

WHEREAS, Hunt County, in accordance with 43 TAC Section 15.55(d), has assigned the value of work from their EMP project to the City of Greenville to be used towards EMP work needed to complete their PWP;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Hunt County performs, or cause to be performed, the following EMP in return for waiver of the local match fund participation requirement on the approved federal off-system bridge program PWP not yet awarded:
