Q1 PREVENTION HIGHLIGHT

Throughout this quarter, Riley has taken the courage to help others by teaching them ways to recognize their emotions and teaching them how to regulate them. She truly has dramatically impacted our Club by modeling how we should encourage one another.

IMPACT: The Club is a safe space for youth- especially for Riley. This semester, Riley was able to take what she learned in Club programs (like how to recognize emotions and how to regulate them once you've identified them) and share that knowledge through peer-to-peer mentoring. She is a great example of how prevention programs create positive ripple effects that result in safer and healthier communities.
