**Whereas**, every 65 seconds, someone in the United States develops Alzheimer's, and worldwide every 3 seconds; and

**Whereas**, worldwide, nearly 50 million people have Alzheimer's or related dementia, and

**Whereas**, in the United States, there are 7 million people living with Alzheimer's disease and unless a cure is found it is estimated that as many as 13 million will have the disease by 2050; and


**Whereas**, nearly two-thirds of those with Alzheimer's disease are women; and

**Whereas**, Alzheimer's is the 7th leading cause of death in the United States; and
