**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN HUNT COUNTY JAIL
AND HUNT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL DISTRICT**

THIS AGREEMENT shall become effective upon execution by both **Hunt County, Texas (“Hunt County”), and Hunt Memorial Hospital District (“HMHD”), a political subdivision of the State of Texas;** jointly referred to herein as “parties”.

WHEREAS, the respective parties are authorized by the Interlocal Cooperation Act, V.T.C.A. Government Code, Chapter 791, to enter into joint contracts and agreements for the performance of governmental functions and services including administrative functions normally associated with the operation of government such as purchasing of necessary materials and supplies;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the parties to comply with and further the policies and purpose of the Interlocal Cooperation Act;

WHEREAS, Hunt County operates the Jail in Hunt County in conformity with Texas law, for the detention of adult inmates arrested, charged with, or serving sentences for violations of criminal statutes;

WHEREAS, HMHD is a political subdivision of the State of Texas and provides hospital services to the people of Hunt County and surrounding areas;

WHEREAS, Hunt County has requested HMHD to provide inmate health services to Hunt County detainees which HMHD desires to provide;

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of each party find that the subject of this agreement is necessary and that each party has the legal authority to perform and to provide the governmental function or service which is the subject matter of this agreement; furthermore, the governing bodies find that the performance of this agreement is in the common interest of both parties; and that the division of cost fairly compensates the performing party for the services performed under this contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto in consideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein and pursuant to the authority permitted under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, promise, and agree as follows:

I.

HMHD agrees to the transfer of and providing care to Hunt County Jail detainees for any inmates with suspected/confirmed tuberculosis or latent tuberculosis infection requiring higher level of care. HMHD also confirms that is has personnel who are licensed in Texas to provide, within the capabilities of the facility, appropriate personnel, equipment, and services to assist with transfer, receipt and treatment of the detainee transferred.

HMHD agrees to the transfer of and providing care to Hunt County Jail detainees for any other medically necessary procedures that it has the capability and ability to provide care

for. HMHD also confirms that is has personnel who are licensed in Texas to provide care for patients with suspected of or confirmed to have tuberculosis.

II.

Hunt County agrees to pay Hunt Memorial Hospital District for all care and treatment performed pursuant to this agreement.

III.

This Agreement shall be in effect from the date of execution until terminated by either party to the agreement.




This agreement shall take effect upon execution of both signatories.

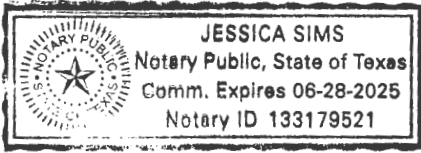
