

RESOLUTION NO. 19,859

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HUNT COUNTY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING TERMINATION OF THE FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT WITH THE QUINLAN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IX OF THE AGREEMENT; DIRECTING NOTICE OF TERMINATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Hunt County, Texas (the "County"), entered into a Fire Protection Agreement (the "Agreement") with the Quinlan Volunteer Fire Department (the "Department"), effective in 2021, pursuant to the authority granted under Texas Local Government Code Chapters 352 and 791, Texas Government Code Chapter 418 Subchapters E and E-1, and Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code Section 78.001, as applicable; and

WHEREAS, Article IX of the Agreement provides that the Agreement may be terminated by either party by giving written notice to the other party sixty (60) days prior to termination, and that such termination will affect the funding provided to the Department; and

WHEREAS, Article XI of the Agreement (regarding Notice) specifies the manner in which notice to the Department shall be sufficient if sent by certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, addressed to the Department at its legal mailing address; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court finds that termination of the Agreement is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Hunt County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HUNT COUNTY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the recitals set forth above are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. That the Commissioners Court hereby authorizes and directs the termination of the Agreement with the Department pursuant to Article IX of the Agreement.

SECTION 3. That the County Judge or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to provide written notice of termination to the Department, in accordance with Article XI of the Agreement, by certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested, addressed to the Quinlan Volunteer Fire Department. The notice shall state that the termination shall be effective ninety (90) days from the date of the notice.

SECTION 4. That upon termination, all funding to the Department under the Agreement shall cease, as provided in Article IX.
